On December 3, 2010, the Court issued an order requesting clarification of the expenses incurred in connection with the fee application. EXPLANATION OF EXPENSES INCURRED

- 1. The Fourth Application for fees and expenses included a request for reimbursement of \$5,781.81 in expenses incurred by counsel for the Receiver, Hawley Troxell Ennis & Hawley.
- 2. Attached Exhibit A lists each expense incurred between April 1, 2010 and September 30, 2010, including the date, amount, purpose of payment, payee, and case identification.
