Based on the Stipulation of the parties, Plaintiff, Securities and Exchange Commission (the “Commission”) and Defendant Daren L. Palmer (“Palmer” or the “Defendant”) and for good cause appearing:

I.

IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendant and his respective officers, agents, servants, employees, attorneys, and those persons in active concert or participation with them who receive actual notice of this Order by personal service or otherwise, and each of them, be restrained and preliminarily enjoined, directly or indirectly, singly or in concert, from future violations of Sections 5(a), 5(c) [15 U.S.C. § 77e(a) and (c)] and 17(a)(1),(2) and (3) [15 U.S.C. § 77q(a)(1), (2) and (3)] of the Securities Act of 1933 (the “Securities Act”) and Section 10(b) [U.S.C. § 778j(b)] of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (the “Exchange Act”) and Rule 10b-5 thereunder [15 and 17 C.F.R. § 240.10b-5].

II.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendant and his respective officers, agents, servants, employees, attorneys, and those persons in active concert or participation with him who receive actual notice of this Order by personal service or otherwise, and each of them, be restrained and preliminarily enjoined, directly or indirectly, singly or in concert, from future violations of Section 15(a) of the Exchange Act [15 U.S.C. § 78o(a)].

III.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that this Order shall remain in full force and effect until final judgment is entered in this action or until further order of the Court.

IV.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction over Defendants upon the entry of this preliminary injunction and other equitable relief for the purpose of implementing and enforcing the terms and conditions contained herein.
