- 1. The Application for payment of fees and expenses is APPROVED. The fees and expenses incurred by Manning Curtis Bradshaw & Bednar LLC and the Receiver, as set forth in the Application, are reasonable and necessary, and may be paid as an expense of administering the receivership estate.
- The Receiver is authorized to pay Manning Curtis Bradshaw & Bednar LLC \$3,168.67 as reimbursement of expenses paid on behalf of the receivership estate and \$67,540.00 in fees for its services rendered for the benefit of the receivership estate from September 1, 2014 through February 28, 2015.
- 3. The Receiver is authorized to receive \$23,201.00 in fees for his services rendered for the benefit of the Receivership Estate from September 1, 2014 through February 28, 2015.
