The matter before the Court is the Receiver's *Motion Seeking Authorization to Sell Almond Heights Lot 25 Free and Clear of Purported Interests Subject to Higher and Better Offers and Memorandum in Support* (the "Motion") filed by R. statements made on the record at the Hearing, and applicable law.

Based thereon, and for good cause appearing,

(1) The Motion is **GRANTED**.

(2) The Court **APPROVES** the Purchase Agreement; and

(3) The Court **AUTHORIZES** the sale of the Property as set forth in the Motion and

pursuant to the Purchase Agreement to David E. Bringhurst or to any higher and better offeror.
