The matter before the Court is the Fourth Interim Fee Application for Receiver and Receiver's Professionals for Services Rendered From January 1, 2014 Through December 31, 2014 [Docket No. 954] (the "Fee Application") filed by R. Wayne Klein, the Court-appointed Receiver (the "Receiver"), seeking the allowance of fees and expenses incurred by the Receiver and his forensic accountants, Klein & Associates, PLLC, and his legal counsel, Dorsey & Whitney LLP, as a cost of administering the Receivership Estate for the period of January 1,

The fees and expenses requested for the Application Period are reasonable, necessary and beneficial. Based thereon, and for good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

(1) The Fee Application is **APPROVED**;

(2) The fees and expenses of the Receiver and his professionals Klein & AssociatesPLLC and Dorsey & Whitney LLP are ALLOWED on an interim basis as set forth in the FeeApplication;

(3) Klein & Associates PLLC is ALLOWED a claim in the total amount of\$351,829.00 for fees and \$259.63 for reimbursement of out-of-pocket expenses;

(4) Dorsey & Whitney LLP is **ALLOWED** a claim in the total amount of \$431,164.50 for fees and \$30,149.94 for reimbursement of out-of-pocket expenses; and

(5) The Receiver is **AUTHORIZED** to pay all fees and expenses as allowed herein.
